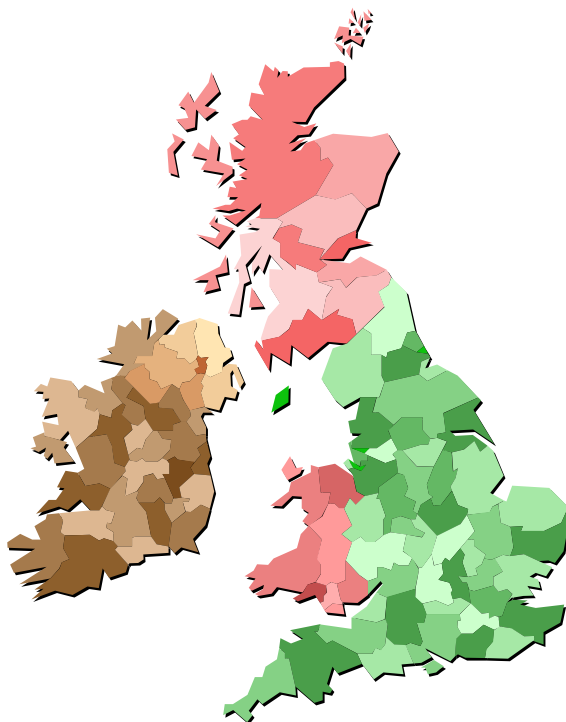
Autumn Term Topics:
