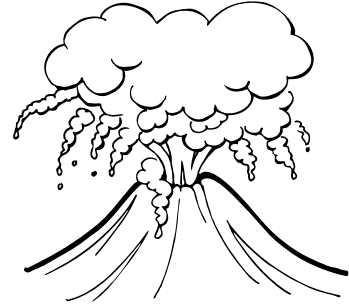

- Earthquakes.



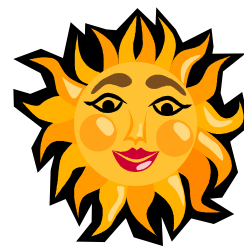
Likely autumn term homework tasks:

- Producing a newspaper report on an actual earthquake.

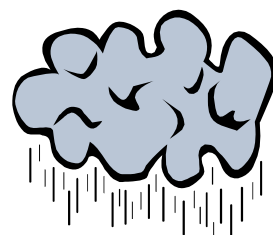
Spring term topics:

- Types of rainfall.

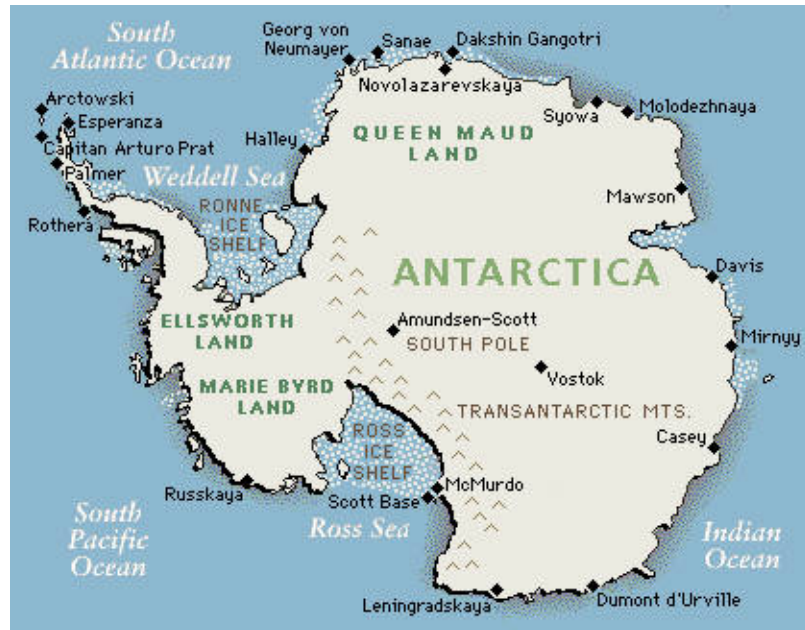


Summer term topics:
