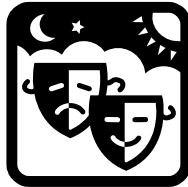


DRAMA



Autumn term

- **Heroes and heroines**
This scheme introduces pupils to the heroes and heroines who have shaped the world as we know it today. We will look at the history surrounding the civil rights movements in America and the decisions made by individuals fighting for change.
- **Protest cross curricular project**
Pupils will create a piece of theatre which explores protest for change based on their own research. This will be a cross curricular project with Art and Music and will culminate in an afternoon of Drama Art and Music for the whole year group.

Homework: research, learning lines and rehearsal

Spring term

- **The stones:**
This scheme of work looks at the play 'the stones'. Pupils use script and look at body language and status to enable them to perform fully rounded characters.
- **Out of their heads**
Pupils look in depth at Marcus Romer's 'out of their heads' a play that explores the pressure on young people to take drugs. Pupils are assessed.

Homework: research, learning lines and rehearsal

Summer term

- **Domestic Violence.**
Pupils look at conflict in relationships and in the family. They will study the role of the onlooker. Pupils will have a broader understanding of why domestic violence occurs, and will create drama using both naturalistic and abstract techniques.
- **Park life**
A scheme to prepare pupils for the demands of GCSE. Pupils will look at a range of characters in every day society, and challenge the notion of stereotypes, to create realistic performances. Pupils will make a final piece and be assessed.
