



# Design and Craft

## Qualification

**Level 1 Design and Craft City and Guilds**

## Objectives

Students study a common unit entitled Design for Craft which introduces them to simple design ideas which are then taken forward to the particular craft. They then design and make a craft item and gain skills in the knowledge of materials, techniques and processes.

Craft courses currently offered include: Copper Foiled Glass, Leaded Glass, Mosaics and Interior Design/Planning a Room.

## Overview

This course is suitable for students who enjoy practical activities. It is suitable for students who want to balance an otherwise academic curriculum with some inspirational creative work.

## Skills

Students will learn design based skills in relation to colour theory, texture, line and shape and practical making skills such as cutting glass, soldering, mosaic techniques and kitchen planning depending on the courses undertaken.

## Course Content

Each different craft course will cover the following topics:

- Design and market influences
- Materials and components
- Products and applications
- Health and Safety

## Assessment

Each unit will be marked by your teacher and externally moderated. There is no examination.
